Your challenge is to complete 15 '  'Helping Hands'.

Once completed hand in to be marked and earn 2 points for your "Services and Duties Badge"

No	Helping hands	LEARNING
1		Interview someone in the community who is involved in a service organisation about their organisation and their role. (e.g. Rotary, red Cross, Salvation Army etc.) Present in an interesting manner
2		Design a pamphlet for Civil Defence in case of an emergency which require evacuation, include items needed for survival of 3 weeks! Heps of colour
3		Do a good deed for someone needy in your community lasting at least an hour. (Must include photos. e.g. mowing lawns, washing windows for no pay). Write up what you did and get the recipient to sign
4		Interview a previous recipient of the Highlands Services and Duties Cup, (a minimum of 12 questions). (Must be signed and documented). The focus of the interview about what they did to receive this award
5		List and briefly explain ten non-profit making service organisations that exist in New Plymouth.
6		Write an essay about one of the service organisations, explaining what they do in the community, Minimum 500 words.
7		Collect 20 community announcements from the newspaper. Present them in an interesting and innovative way
8		Make a brochure including a map detailing at least 10 activities suitable for the Elderly and Disabled people. (e.g. wheelchair friendly tracks etc.).



9		Design a poster to encourage people to get involved in a voluntary community service group.
10		Write a letter of application for a school Service and Duty job.
11		Write a 2 page or biography of a services role model. (e.g. Mother Theresa, Florence Nightingale, Sir Edmund Hillary)
12 **		Make a papier maché model of Mother Theresa, Florence Nightingale, Sir Edmund Hillary or other role model.
13 **		Undertake a Community Project (e.g. clean up the beach/park area, plant a tree etc. (Must be signed by project leader).
14 **		Be involved in a fundraising event. (e.g. collector for Daffodil Day. (Must be signed by project leader).
15 **		Write a letter to a Service Group. (e.g. Rotary). Detailing something which you have identified as a service which has not yet been filled in the community.
16 **		Write an explanation of the purpose and use for the 'The House for Karen'
17 *		Design a flag to promote a community service group with an explanation of the design.
18 *		Design an advertisement to find a home for a homeless animal.
19 *		Design a poster for "Clean up New Zealand Day".
