You have to complete 3 tasks from section A and 3 tasks from section B

Section A

Task 1. Complete 3 chess.com lessons then reflect on what you learned in each lesson by writing a paragraph. [Chess.com](https://www.chess.com) Video yourself doing the lessons

Task 2. Survey your class. Find out and present information on the following - How many know how to play chess, How many would like to learn how to play, how many consider chess a sport. Present your findings on a chart/graph and explain in writing what you found out.

Task 3. Research the origins of the game of chess, where it was created and why they created it. Present this information as a report. Remember to include where you accessed information from. This needs to be at least 300 words long. Include where you found information.

Task 4. Record yourself doing 5 chess puzzles on chess.com (it can be a rush puzzle to a daily puzzle)

Task 5. Create a profile on a famous chess player from any country
You may do a famous chess player even if they are not alive today. This must include a photo of this person and be at least 2 pages long. Please remember to include where you accessed information from.

Section B

Task 1. Record yourself playing 3 different chess games against a **COMPUTER**
Must be against level intermediate or above.

Task 2. Learn about 2 chess openings. Write a paragraph explaining each opening sequence and why you would choose these. [Chess.com](https://www.chess.com)

Task 3. Learn about En-passant pawn. Explain how and when this move can be used.

Task 4. Research a famous chess game and describe in proper chess language: what happened, who was playing, where it was played. Explain why it is famous/well known.

Task 5. Create you own chess board and pieces. Choose a theme to create the pieces needed to play a game: IE Food, Culture, Sport.
