

Conflicts Badge

Choose a combination of the tasks below that add up to 10 🇳🇿 . Complete each of these tasks in full then submit your completed badgework to the DPs office.

Please ensure that you have included where you found any information you have researched to complete these tasks. Do not cut/copy and paste information please. Ensure that you have rewritten information into your own words.

This Badge is worth 2 points towards your Academic Badge.

- Write a summary about five different conflicts. One paragraph on each conflict. Find out and include: Where the conflict occurred, Which countries were directly involved, How many casualties were there, Why did the conflict start, how did the conflict end. Example conflicts could be: WW1, WW2, Boer War, NZ Land Wars ,Vietnam War, Korean War 🇳🇿 🇳🇿
- Choose a piece of equipment that has been widely used in various conflicts and explain how this piece of equipment has been developed/changed or improved over time. Example pieces of equipment could include - rifles, tanks, aircraft, submarines, radios/communication equipment. Must be at least a full page of written information plus labelled diagrams/pictures of your chosen type of equipment. 🇳🇿 🇳🇿
- Compare and contrast the uniform and personal equipment worn/used by a soldier in WW1 compared to a modern day soldier. Include labelled diagrams and list the equipment these soldiers would have access to. 🇳🇿 🇳🇿
- On a world map of at least A4 size label where at least 10 major conflicts have occurred - include which countries/groups were involved in each conflict and which year these conflicts took place. Remember that maps have a title, key, scale and have colour. 🇳🇿 🇳🇿 **This is a compulsory task.**
- Create a 2 page profile on a well known leader from a conflict - this could be a head of state, general or admiral. This needs to include pictures and information on their life and involvement within the selected conflict/s - EG Winston Churchill, Te Whiti Rongomai, Joseph Stalin. 🇳🇿 🇳🇿
- Create an A4 size timeline of one major conflict. This must include at least 10 significant situations from the chosen conflict. 🇳🇿

- Create a report about an invention that has come about from a conflict or was significantly improved/developed through its use in a conflict. Something that people use daily. This needs to be at least one A4 page of information and also include pictures/diagrams - EG: Sonar, radar, Instant coffee, The Microwave Oven, duct tape, nylon, GPS, superglue. 🇳🇿
- During WW2 many things were developed to solve problems on the battlefield/zone - select one of the following inventions and explain why it was developed, who developed it and whether it was successful.
 - Flail tank, Bouncing bomb, Drop tanks, Duplex drive tank, Liberty ship, A Bomb, V Bomb.
 - Must be at least an A4 page worth of information and also include diagrams, pictures. 🇳🇿
- Create a flow chart that plots at least 10 conflicts over time. Include where, when and who was involved. This needs to be an A4 page of information. Make sure its colourful and eye-catching and interesting to read. 🇳🇿
- Draw a scene from a battle in one of the following wars in Vietnam, WW2, WW1, Boer, NZL land wars and Korean War. It must be detailed and include a few sentences describing what is happening in the picture. Must be at Least A4 size hand drawn and be colourful. 🇳🇿
- Research and display on a bar graph the number of New Zealanders killed/wounded in the various conflicts we have been involved in . Start with the New Zealand Land Wars. Remember to label your graph and ensure it has a title. 🇳🇿
- Make a shoe box diorama of a conflict it must be detailed and show a battle from one of the following wars Vietnam, WW2, WW1, Boer, Korean War NZL land wars . 🇳🇿 🇳🇿
- Create a movie poster of at least A3 size that advertises a well known movie about a conflict. 🇳🇿
