Pick 4 activities from list A

List A:

- 1: There are lots of different ways to interact with friends! Draw a comic about how you'd like to spend time with a friend. This will need to be at least three A4 Pages in length - with six boxes per page. This needs to be hand - but don't panic, it doesn't need to be art gallery quality.
- 2: Find websites for 2 neurodiversity coaching places in Taranaki and describe what they do. Each description needs to be at least 100 words in length.
- 3: Interview a student that is neurodivergent and ask them what are two things they want people to know about how their brain works.
- 4: There are so many different names for ways our minds might work. Create a hand drawn poster that lists and describes 5 types of neurodivergence. This poster needs to be A3 in size and be bright and colourful.
- 5: Interview 2 teachers and ask them "what they do to make their classrooms more inclusive for all types of brains." Make sure there are at least 5 interview questions.
- 6: Nature can be so satisfying and calming! Find at least 4 things outside that are satisfying or soothing to touch and photograph them.

Pick 2 of the activities from the list below.

List B:

- 1: Create a fidget to help you focus or calm down. It must be made out of recycled materials. You need to take photos of your process of making it.
- 2: Make a slide show or a short movie to tell people about neurodiversity. It has to be at least one minute long.
- 3: We might experience environments in different ways. Draw a picture of a place where you feel most relaxed. A4 Size - this can be coloured or black and white.
- 4: Create a profile on a well known person that is neurodivergent - investigate and share in a creative way information about this persons challenges and successes. Eg. Emma Watson, Michelangelo, Simone Biles, Sir Isaac Newton.
